The Planning Commission talked briefly about the placement of lines and markings for a bike trail along Rt. 611. It was agreed it would also be good to place bike markings along Fern and Springhill to connect the trail to Rt. 611. The Planning Commission then talked briefly about continuing to explore the placement of trees, benches and rain cover over the bench along the trail through the Borough. Damion Newton had not been able to meet with the arborist in Easton yet but expected to meet with him in the next week. He will get at that time the contact information on the person that does grant writing for Easton and forward that to Beth Baird. He will explore with him appropriate trees for shade along the trail as well as other trees throughout the Borough. It was agreed that we should look at getting 3 tree groupings and 4 benches for placement along the trail. Two sets of trees and benches should be south of Delaware and one bench north of Delaware along the cemetery property which has shade trees along the property line. An additional set and bench should be placed in the north section near Ash Lane.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m. with a motion by Damion Newton and seconded by Jason Anderson. The next meeting will be held on August 3, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Riegelsville Borough Hall.
