A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RIEGELSVILLE, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARATION TO DISCONTINUE THE STATE DECLARATION COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2020. Mayor Gregory Stokes declared a disaster emergency in Riegelsville Borough pertaining to the Covid-19 pandemic (the "Local Declaration"): and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Act, 35 P.S. § 7501(b) states that ratification by the governing body is required to extend a local disaster emergency declaration beyond (7) days: and


WHEREAS, the Covid-19 pandemic is an ongoing disaster emergency, the end of which cannot be predicted by Riegelsville Borough Council and Mayor Stokes at this time;

1. Ratification of Disaster Emergency Declaration. The Local Declaration was ratified on March 25, 2020
2. Term of Emergency Declaration. The Local Declaration shall remain in place until the Borough Council discontinues the State Declaration.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Riegelsville, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows: **Declaration to discontinue the state declaration Covid-19 pandemic.**




